- ❖ Sotto-campione di circa 4500 studenti va sempre a comporre la nostra rappresentanza a livello internazionale

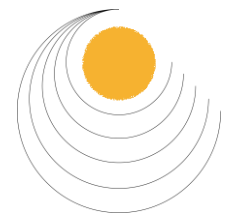
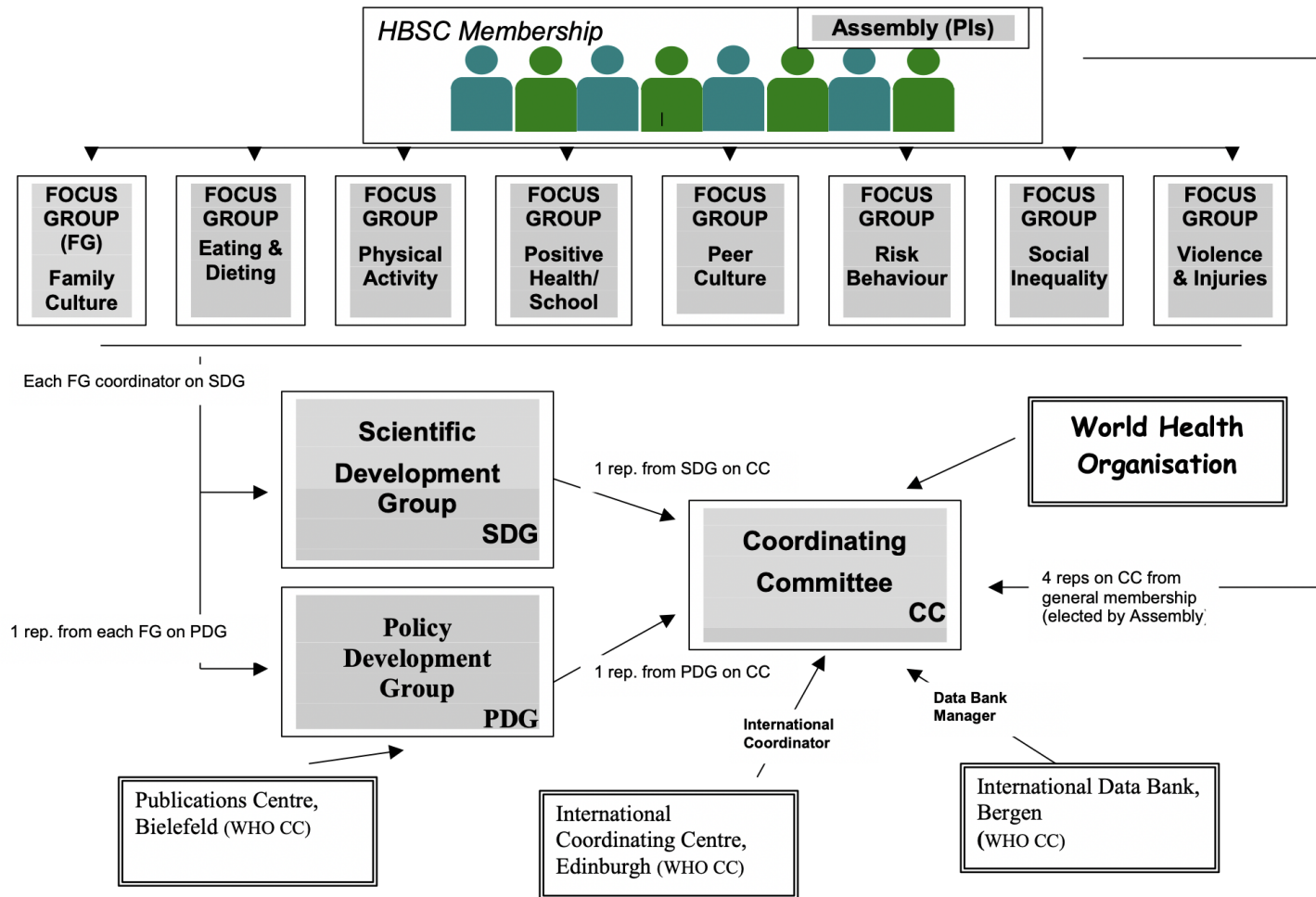


Stare dentro ad un network di ricerca

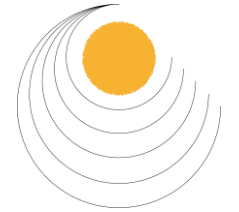

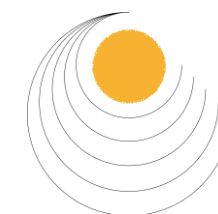

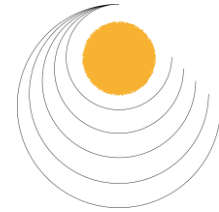
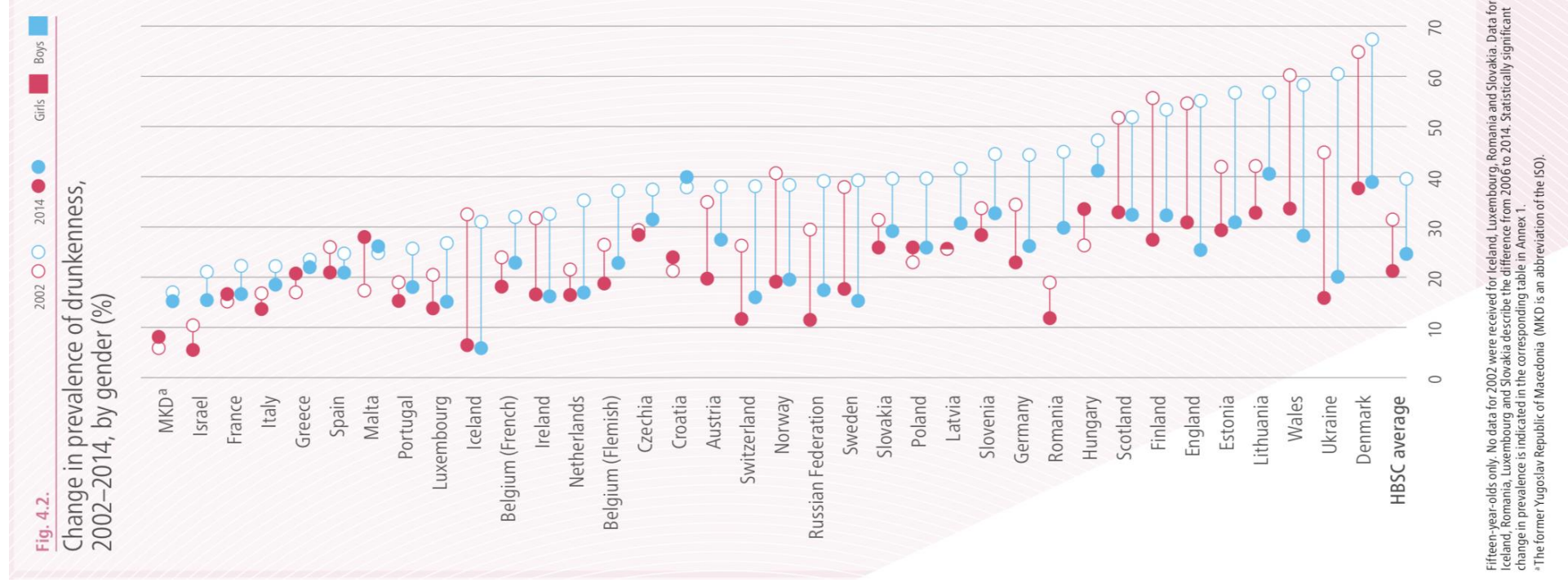
Trend nell'uso regolare di alcol (sub-region)
